**125TH FIGHTER WING
COMMANDER'S ENVIRONMENTAL STATEMENT**

1. The 125th Fighter Wing (125 FW) operates 19 F-15 Eagle air superiority fighters, one RC-26 Counterdrug and one C-130 aircraft. The 125 FW is assigned to the 1st Air Force, and performs both homeland defense and expeditionary combat missions. The 125 FW maintains continuous F-15 air sovereignty alert at Homestead ARB, Florida, and is a force provider to Air Combat Command in support of the Air Expeditionary Force. The 125 FW also supports state and local missions under the command of the Adjutant General of Florida that provides trained and equipped personnel to protect life and property, and to preserve peace, order and public safety.
2. Environmental protection is a high priority for management, as well as the responsibility of every worker, contractor, and supplier. Our vision is to reduce or eliminate waste streams through pollution prevention and continual improvement processes to our impacts on manmade and natural resources. Additionally, the 125FW will maintain compliance with all applicable environmental requirements to include federal, state, and local requirements regulations, as well as other requirements such as Executive Orders and Air Force Instructions.
