**125TH FIGHTER WING
COMMANDER'S ENVIRONMENTAL STATEMENT**

1. The 125th Fighter Wing (125 FW) operates F-15 Eagle air dominant fighters, and an RC-26 Counterdrug aircraft. The 125 FW is assigned to the 1st Air Force, and performs both homeland defense and expeditionary combat missions. The 125 FW maintains continuous F-15 aerospace control alert at Homestead ARB, Florida, and is a force provider to Air Combat Command in support of the Air Expeditionary Force. The 125 FW also supports state and local missions under the command of the Adjutant General of Florida. The 125 FW provides trained and equipped personnel to protect life and property, and to preserve peace, order and public safety.
2. Environmental protection is a high priority for management, as well as the responsibility of every worker, contractor and supplier. Our vision is to reduce or eliminate waste streams through pollution prevention and continual improvement processes to our impacts on manmade and natural resources.
